What is the Past Presidents' Legacy Fund (PPLF) Professional Development Grant 2010?

The PPLF Professional Development Grant 2010 for an Educator in a New Professional Role provides a minimum of \$100 toward expenses associated with the MRA 2010 Annual Conference. It is the belief that involvement with and participation in the Michigan Reading Association will contribute significantly to educators' professional development.

Who May Apply?
